- Are your most critical test cases clearly documented and up to date?
- Can someone else run and understand those test cases if needed?
- Is test automation in place for key user flows?
- Are edge cases and recent regressions properly handled?
- Are upcoming vacations aligned with your release calendar?
- Is there a designated backup for QA-related questions or urgent issues?
- Will someone monitor test results and triage failures during absences?
- Are high-risk features prioritized for testing?
- What can be safely postponed or tested later?
- Are credentials, test data, and environments pre-configured for others?
- Can external or temporary testers access your tools if needed?
- Does the rest of the team know what to expect from QA while someone's away?
